Please find enclosed a copy of the Public Path Diversion Order made by the Council on 7th February 2019. This Order has been made to divert

- a section of Public Footpath (FP) BA15/27 from a junction with Hunstrete Lane and FP BA15/35 proceeding to a point at grid reference ST 6479 6218 on the boundary of Dave Crookes Fishery, Hunstrete to a new route to be created through the wooded area and along the side of the parking area from a new junction with FP BA15/35 to the same point on the boundary; and
- 2. a section of FP 8A15/35 from a junction with Hunstrete Lane and FP BA15/27 proceeding to a point at grid reference ST 6462 6228 to a route slightly further south from a new junction with Hunstrete Lane to the same point at grid reference ST 6479 6248. This new route is the route currently walked by the public;

as shown on the order map.

The Order has been made without any limitations; however kissing gates will be authorised under section 147 of the Act at fence boundaries to prevent the ingress and egress of livestock.

The Order has been made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, and I am required by Schedule 6 of the legislation to serve you with Notice of the making of this Order. Please find enclosed for your records

This order is made by Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the occupiers of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the paths should be diverted.

Bathampton Angling Association has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Hunstrete, Marksbury and shown by bold continuous lines on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up from the date that the authority certifies that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new public footpaths described in Article 3 into a fit condition for use by the public.
- 2. No statutory undertakers rights are affected by this order.
- 3. There shall, on the date that the authority certifies that the works to bring the new site of the paths described in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public have been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the authority, be public footpaths over the land situate at Hunstrete, Marksbury described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the map contained in this order.
- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.
