Minutes of the Marksbury Parish Council (MPC) Meeting

1. To accept Apologies for Absence

None received. It was noted that Cllr Andrew Bendall was not in attendance.

2. To Approve minutes of the previous meeting held on 19th March 2024

Approved, proposed by Cllr Alistair Hardwick and seconded by Cllr Richard Lord.

3. Matter Arising

- Nat West action completed
- Hunstrete Speedwatch is on hold as PCSO seconded elsewhere until Oct 24
- Fix My Street Verges reported actions on this portal in the Parish remain outstanding MM reported public rights of way (PROW) are currently not a priority at BaNES.
- Village Hall in Marksbury has addressed the tree guery.
- Youth club funds query is now actioned.

4. Declarations of Interest from any members of any items to be discussed None.

5. To Adjourn for Public Participation

Matt from Marksbury School PTA provided a slide presentation updating the PC on the energy project at the school and the next steps. (Slides will be available on the MPC website.)

- 1. 8 successful grant applications totalled £15.2k, PTA fund raising, and direction donations added a further £14,8K = £35k total raised
- 2. Predicted a 50% reduction in the £3k a month energy costs
- 3. The next plan is to build the solar and battery capacity more funds are to be raised from Autumn onwards

Action: Slides onto MPC website

Lisa from European Energy, (EE)

- 1. The solar farm is going to plan and on schedule to GO Live end Sept/early Oct
- 2. Panels will start arriving over the next few weeks
- 3. Testing will take place once hooked up to the National Grid.
- 4. The testing outcome determines the grant then awarded.
- 5. Estimated to be around £40k.

- 6. EE creates a legal agreement with criteria with MPC and develops application forms for awards from the grant.
- I. The application form will be published on the MPC website, and a notification made locally.
- II. Forms go through an application review process.
- III. The shortlist from MPC goes to EE.
- IV. EE assesses against the agreement criteria, does necessary due diligence, and then pays directly to the award recipients.
- V. EE keeps MPC updated on awards made and the number of monies still available.

Action: MPC to work with EE legal representative on the awards process and criteria. MPC to create a working party

(Quartet Foundation and Chelwood Community Fund have information to be reviewed.)
